

## **Danny Wong**

Mr. Wong Danny F., aged 51, holds a Bachelor degree in Economics and Accounting from China Central University of Finance and Economics. Mr. Wong has over 20 years of experience in Corporate Finance, listing, providing training for financial professionals and investment in Chinese B shares, H shares, red-chip shares and asset management. Mr. Wong had successfully assisted dozens of Chinese high-tech companies to obtain listed status on Hong Kong Stock Exchange.

Mr. Wong commenced his career in the area of financial professional training and publishing in 1996. He was the President of the Asia Region of a financial training institute, Dearborn Financial Institute. He designed and developed training courses for Stock Exchanges of various countries, such as Hong Kong, Singapore, China and Japan, as well as investment banks from US and Europe. In 1998, he worked for Pacific World and Federal Asset Management as an Executive Director of Asia Pacific Region and was responsible for the sales and marketing of offshore funds in Asia Pacific. From 1999 to 2001, Mr. Wong was the founder of the first venture capital company in China, namely Shenzhen Venture Capital Group. This Venture Capital company involved the participation of the Shenzhen local government. From 2001 to 2005, Mr. Wong was the Executive Director of Sun Hung Kai International Limited. He was in charge of investment banking and responsible for public listing of companies; fund raising for private and listed companies and trust and investment services for private and professional organizations.

Mr. Wong is the Chairman of Beijing Financial Group Limited. Beijing Financial Group Limited covers a full financial industry chain, including brokerage company, asset management company and wealth management company established in Hong Kong. Mr. Wong has been involved in the medical industry in China for the past 20 years and has made substantial investments in the industry for many years. Mr. Wong has carried out substantial researches in the Stem Cells development for the past few years and has visited Stem Cells companies in Japan, China, Ukraine, France and other countries to gain firsthand knowledge of their development.

Recently, Mr. Wong has established Medisun Holdings Limited, a group of companies which commits to the stem cell regenerative bio-medical industry and engages in applying the stem cell regenerative medical technology to provide advices and services to clients seeking alternative medical treatment for various health related matters. The group has engaged stem cell experts to provide the technology know how for its operation in Hong Kong and it is building a laboratory and a clinic in Hong Kong for the research and operations.

Mr. Wong also actively participates in charity works in different countries. Mr. Wong is the trustee of Eisenhower Foundation. The Foundation is founded to help the minority children, youth, families and neighborhoods in disadvantaged American cities. He is also one of the sponsors of the Kennedy Forum which is established by the Kennedy family. In additions, Mr. Wong has sponsored over 400 orphans and children in China in the past ten years. He will keep on promoting and assisting the people in needs around the world.
